Building Envelope Review Services

The Plaza 2006 Building is a new teaching facility at Brock University, which achieved LEED® Silver Certification. The building includes a bookstore, classrooms, faculty office space and lounge/meeting areas. The complex building envelope contained unique details that required close coordination between Morrison Hershfield, the architect, general contractor, and sub-trades.
