### **The City of Prince Albert - Saskatchewan Fire and Emergency Services Master Plan**

Prince Albert in Saskatchewan has a population of 40,000 and an area of approximately 70.67 sq km, most of which is in the river valley of the North Saskatchewan River. As the largest municipality in the northern part of the province, it attracts over 150,000 people annually over and above the permanent citizens of Prince Albert. Morrison Hershfield was hired to conduct a full review of the current Fire and Emergency Services providing a master plan for the future direction of the department.



### **Ontario Emergency Management Centre**

Morrison Hershfield was hired to provide project administration services and to develop location/site selection criteria for a new Ontario Emergency Management Centre. The new facility accommodates Emergency Management Ontario, the Provincial Emergency Operation Centre, and Public Safety Canada, and was designed as a post disaster facility with regular capacity for 80 staff, but with accommodation up to 170 people during an emergency. All critical systems and equipment were designed with an N+1 redundancy.



### **Municipal Emergency Plan**

MH completed a review and rewrite of the Municipal Emergency Plan for Yellowhead County, Alberta, plus review and recommendations on the requirements for a new Emergency Operations Centre. The approach taken on the Municipal Emergency Plan included an upgraded format so that the document was user-friendly and flowed, as would the actions required to manage an emergency event. Significant effort was placed on creating a quick reference and effective guide for each role and responsibility.
